The appellants herein are at liberty to file necessary petition for impleadment in that remanded matter before the Joint Commissioner and contest the matter if so advised. The Joint Commissioner is requested to dispose of the above O.A. after affording the appellants, the respondents and other persons having interest if any an opportunity of being heard and pass order in accordance with law within a period of 3 months. The appellants and respondents shall also co-operate for the expeditious disposal of the O.A. enquiry without any default. With these directions the appeal petition is disposed of.
